CLASSES

CLASSES

Ceramics – C. Bakewell; Offered Sessions I, II, and III
Ceramics students will learn techniques in hand building, sculpture and decoration. They will discover the origins and vocabulary of clay and encounter outstanding and inspirational artists.

Comics Art – Z. Eichert; Offered Session II: create an original booklet over several intense days of drawing exercises, character and story development, and investigations into the art of cartoons and comic books.

Digital Photography – J. Applebee; Offered Session I
We will concentrate on photography, learning fundamentals of focus, composition, lighting. We will edit our photos on the computers. Student taking this session must bring their own digital camera – two to five megapixel models are optimal for our purposes.

Mosaic Madness – S. Howe; Offered Session II: take a journey through the exquisite world of mosaic. Students will explore a variety of mosaic techniques from paper mosaic to authentic pique assiette projects for home and garden. A kaleidoscope of color.

Music – Z. Eichert; Offered Session I and III
Learn to play hand drums, build a monochord, explore the fundamentals of music theory, and perform an original song

CLASSES...

Papier Mache Sculpture – S. Howe; Offered Session I
Come explore the limitless magic of papier mache as we create outrageous masks, creatures and more. Students will imagine, design, build, paint and embellish their own amazing 3-D sculptures!

Printmaking/Bookmaking - S. Howe; Offered Session III: this will be a fun and very creative class. Students will explore a variety of simple printmaking processes including; marbling, stamp making, mono printing and more. Students will then create personal, altered or Japanese bound books, in which they will use their prints.

Reader's Theater – R. Craighead; Offered Sessions I, II, and III: do you like reading plays? Reader's Theater is for anyone who would like to take part in reading and performing short plays. We will be reading several plays and choosing one to perform. Join us for some fun playing games, reading, acting, making simple props, and performing.

Young Writer's Salon – J. Applebee; Offered Session II: we will focus on writing and illustrating our work with drawings and/or photos. Students will be given sketchbooks to use in the afternoons when we are away from classroom at the park and library.

INSTRUCTORS

***Webmaster-y** - J. Applebee; Offered Session III: we will use the Mozilla Composer and PowerPoint to incorporate the students' work from other sessions into web sites and/or slide presentations of student writing and art.
